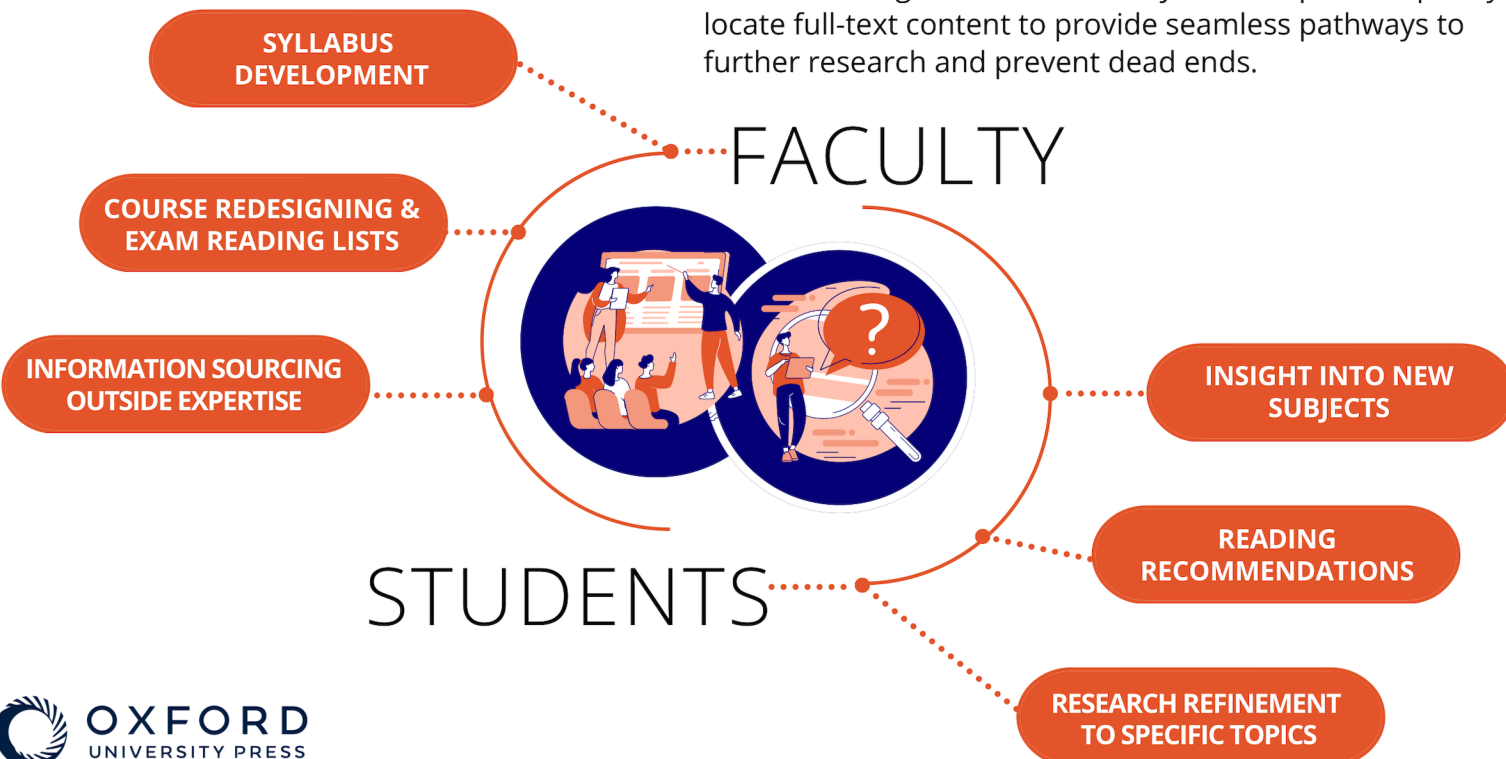
While other resources simply cite scholarship in support of a claim, OBO explains what that book or article is and how it fits within a topic's literature.
